A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize a grant program for addressing dental workforce needs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Action for Dental Health*
5 *Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. ACTION FOR DENTAL HEALTH.**

7 *Section 340G(f) of the Public Health Service Act (42*
8 *U.S.C. 256g(f)) is amended by striking “\$13,903,000 for*
9 *each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023” and inserting*
10 *“\$15,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026 through 2030,*
11 *to remain available until expended”.*

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
