A BILL

To amend the Mineral Leasing Act to extend the period of time during which the Secretary of the Interior is required to collect a fee for each new application for a permit to drill, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “License to Drill Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. BLM OIL AND GAS PERMIT PROCESSING FEE.**

6 Section 35(d) of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C.
7 191(d)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “2026” and
9 inserting “2037”;

10 (2) in paragraph (3)—

11 (A) by striking “Of the fees collected
12 under this subsection for a fiscal year, the” and
13 inserting “The”; and

14 (B) by striking “transfer—” and all that
15 follows through “the Fund” and inserting
16 “transfer, for each of fiscal years 2027 through
17 2037, all of the fees collected under this sub-
18 section for each such fiscal year to the BLM
19 Permit Processing Improvement Fund”; and

20 (3) in paragraph (4), by striking “2026” and
21 inserting “2037”.
