Mr. PFLUGER (for himself, Mr. ISSA, and Mr. ELLZEY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the President to award the Medal of Honor to Robert Lodge for acts of valor as a member of the Air Force during the Vietnam War.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Robert Lodge Medal
5 of Honor Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR AWARD OF MEDAL OF HONOR**
2 **TO ROBERT LODGE FOR ACTS OF VALOR AS A**
3 **MEMBER OF THE AIR FORCE DURING THE**
4 **VIETNAM WAR.**

5 (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—Notwithstanding the time lim-
6 itations specified in section 9274 of title 10, United States
7 Code, or any other time limitation with respect to the
8 awarding of certain medals to persons who served in the
9 Armed Forces, the President is authorized to award the
10 Medal of Honor, under section 9271 of such title, to Rob-
11 ert Lodge for the acts of valor described in subsection (b).

12 (b) **ACTS OF VALOR DESCRIBED.**—The acts of valor
13 described in this subsection are the actions of Robert
14 Lodge as a member of the Air Force on May 10, 1972,
15 during the Vietnam War.
