# H. R. 9207

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude pensions of members of the Armed Forces from gross income.

Mr. VAN DREW introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

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## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude pensions of members of the Armed Forces from gross income.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Pension Pro-  
5 tection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FROM GROSS INCOME OF PENSIONS OF**  
7 **MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Part III of subchapter B of chap-  
9 ter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended  
10 by inserting after section 112 the following new section:

1 **“SEC. 113. PENSIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

2 “Gross income shall not include any amount received  
3 as a pension or annuity from the Federal Government for  
4 service as a member of the Armed Forces of the United  
5 States (whether received by such member or a beneficiary  
6 of such member).”.

7 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
8 for part III of subchapter B of chapter 1 of such Code  
9 is amended by inserting after the item relating to section  
10 112 the following new item:

“Sec. 113. Pensions of members of the Armed Forces.”.

11 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
12 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after  
13 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
