Mrs. MILLER-MEEKS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act to require certain facilities to post prices on the walls.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prices on the Wall
5 Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIRING CERTAIN FACILITIES TO POST PRICES**

7 **ON THE WALLS.**

8 Section 2718 of the Public Health Service Act (42
9 U.S.C. 300gg–18) is amended by adding at the end the
10 following new subsection:

1 “(f) REQUIREMENT TO POST PRICES ON THE
2 WALLS.—

3 “(1) HOSPITALS.—Each hospital operating in
4 the United States shall, beginning January 1, 2028,
5 post on the wall of such hospital (in such areas as
6 specified by the Secretary) the discounted cash price,
7 as applicable, expressed as a dollar amount, for each
8 Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services-specified
9 shoppable service that is furnished by the hospital
10 when provided in, as applicable, the inpatient setting
11 and outpatient department setting (or, in the case
12 no discounted cash price is available for such service,
13 the median cash price charged by the hospital to
14 self-pay individuals for such service when provided in
15 such settings for the previous 3 years, expressed as
16 a dollar amount).

17 “(2) AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTERS.—Each
18 ambulatory surgical center operating in the United
19 States shall, beginning January 1, 2028, post on the
20 wall of such center (in such areas as specified by the
21 Secretary) the discounted cash price, as applicable,
22 expressed as a dollar amount, for each Centers for
23 Medicare & Medicaid Services-specified shoppable
24 service that is furnished by the center (or, in the
25 case no discounted cash price is available for such

1 service, the median cash price charged by the center
2 to self-pay individuals for such service for the pre-
3 vious 3 years, expressed as a dollar amount).

4 “(3) LABORATORIES.—Each laboratory oper-
5 ating in the United States shall, beginning January
6 1, 2028, post on the wall of such laboratory (in such
7 areas as specified by the Secretary) the discounted
8 cash price, as applicable, expressed as a dollar
9 amount, for each specified clinical diagnostic labora-
10 tory test that is a Centers for Medicare & Medicaid
11 Services-specified shoppable service furnished by the
12 laboratory (or, if no such price exists, the gross
13 charge for such test).

14 “(4) PROVIDERS FURNISHING IMAGING SERV-
15 ICES.—Each provider of services and supplier fur-
16 nishing imaging services operating in the United
17 States shall, beginning January 1, 2028, post on the
18 wall of such provider or supplier (in such areas as
19 specified by the Secretary) the discounted cash price,
20 as applicable, expressed as a dollar amount, for each
21 imaging service that is a Centers for Medicare &
22 Medicaid Services-specified shoppable service fur-
23 nished by the provider or supplier (or, in the case
24 no such price exists, the gross charge for such serv-
25 ice).

1 “(5) DEFINITIONS.—In this subsection:

2 “(A) DISCOUNTED CASH PRICE.—The
3 term ‘discounted cash price’ means the charge
4 that applies to an individual who pays cash, or
5 cash equivalent, for an item or service.

6 “(B) SHOPPABLE SERVICE.—The term
7 ‘shoppable service’ means a service that can be
8 scheduled by a health care consumer in advance
9 and includes all ancillary items and services
10 customarily furnished as part of such service.

11 “(C) SPECIFIED CLINICAL DIAGNOSTIC
12 LABORATORY TEST.—The term ‘specified clin-
13 ical diagnostic laboratory test’ means a clinical
14 diagnostic laboratory test other than an ad-
15 vanced diagnostic laboratory test (as defined in
16 section 1834A(d)(5) of the Social Security
17 Act).”.

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
