Ms. VAN DUYNE (for herself, Mr. JACKSON of Texas, Mr. STEUBE, and Mr. GILL of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide for denaturalization of certain persons who provide support for terrorism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Getting Terrorist Fa-
5 natics Out Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. DENATURALIZATION FOR TERRORIST OFFENSES.**

7 Section 340(e) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1451(e)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “When a person shall be con-
2 victed” and inserting the following:

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—When a person shall be
4 convicted”; and

5 (2) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(2) TERRORIST OFFENSES.—When a person
7 shall be convicted under section 2339A or under sec-
8 tion 2339B of title 18, United States Code, the
9 court in which such conviction is had shall thereupon
10 revoke, set aside, and declare void the final order ad-
11 mitting such person to citizenship, and shall declare
12 the certificate of naturalization of such person to be
13 canceled. Jurisdiction is hereby conferred on the
14 courts having jurisdiction of the trial of such offence
15 to make such adjudication.”.

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
