7        (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the  
8 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on June  
9 24, 2026, for a ceremony to dedicate the

1 Semiquincentennial Congressional Time Capsule in honor  
2 of the 250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration  
3 of Independence.

4 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the  
5 ceremony described in subsection (a) shall be carried out  
6 in accordance with such conditions as the Architect of the  
7 Capitol may prescribe.
