Mr. DESAULNIER submitted the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require the United States and the States to jointly ensure a high-quality education to all persons within the United States.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following article is proposed as an amendment
4 to the Constitution of the United States, which shall be
5 valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitu-
6 tion when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of
7 the several States within seven years after the date of its
8 submission for ratification:

1 “ARTICLE —

2 “SECTION 1. The United States, the States, Indian
3 Tribes, and territories shall jointly ensure a high-quality
4 education to all persons within the United States.

5 “SECTION 2. The Congress shall have power to en-
6 force and implement this article by appropriate legisla-
7 tion.”.

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
