Mr. RASKIN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7007) to govern
on behalf of the American people.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 7007) to govern on behalf of
4 the American people. All points of order against consider-
5 ation of the bill are waived. An amendment in the nature
6 of a substitute received for printing in the portion of the
7 Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
8 clause 8 of rule XVIII dated at least one day before the
9 day of consideration of H.R. 7007, if submitted by the
10 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Judici-

1 ary, shall be considered as adopted. If more than one such
2 amendment is submitted, then only the last amendment
3 submitted shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as
4 amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order
5 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The
6 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
7 bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto,
8 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
9 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the
11 Judiciary or their respective designees; and (2) one motion
12 to recommit.

13 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
14 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 7007.

15 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
16 sage that the House has passed H.R. 7007 no later than
17 three calendar days after passage.
