## AN ACT

To allow the U.S. Marshals Service to assist in certain Tribal criminal matters, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal Warrant Fair-  
3 ness Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

5 In this Act, the term “Indian Tribe” means any In-  
6 dian or Alaska Native tribe, band, nation, pueblo, village,  
7 community, component band, or component reservation in-  
8 dividually identified (including parenthetically) on the  
9 most recent list published by the Secretary of the Interior  
10 under section 104 of the Federally Recognized Indian  
11 Tribe List Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 5131).

12 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS.**

13 (a) U.S. MARSHALS SERVICE.—Section 566(e)(1) of  
14 title 28, United States Code, is amended—

15 (1) in subparagraph (B), by inserting “includ-  
16 ing Tribal fugitive matters (on the request of an In-  
17 dian Tribe, as defined in section 2 of the Tribal  
18 Warrant Fairness Act, as applicable),” after “mat-  
19 ters,”; and

20 (2) in subparagraph (D), by inserting “Tribal,”  
21 after “local,”.

22 (b) PRESIDENTIAL THREAT PROTECTION ACT OF  
23 2000.—Section 6 of the Presidential Threat Protection  
24 Act of 2000 (34 U.S.C. 41503) is amended—

25 (1) in subsection (a)—

1 (A) by inserting “and Indian Tribes, as de-  
2 fined in section 2 of the Tribal Warrant Fair-  
3 ness Act” after “components”; and

4 (B) by striking “and local” and inserting  
5 “local, and Tribal”; and

6 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “Federal or  
7 State law” and inserting “Federal, State, or Tribal  
8 law”.
