Ms. CORTEZ MASTO introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To provide funding for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Homes First
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PRO-**
7 **GRAM.**

8 Notwithstanding any provision of the Full-Year Con-
9 tinuing Appropriations and Extensions Act, 2025 or the
10 National Security, Department of State, and Related Pro-
11 grams Appropriations Act, 2026, from the funds appro-

1 priated under either such Act, the Secretary of State and
2 the President shall—

3 (1) not make available, after the date of enact-
4 ment of this Act, any of those appropriated funds
5 for the Board of Peace designated by President
6 Trump through Executive Order 14375 (91 Fed.
7 Reg. 2837; relating to designating the Board of
8 Peace as a public international organization entitled
9 to enjoy certain privileges, exemptions, and immuni-
10 ties); and

11 (2) transfer \$1,000,000,000 of those appro-
12 priated funds to the Secretary of Health and Human
13 Services to carry out the Low-Income Home Energy
14 Assistance Act of 1981 (42 U.S.C. 8621 et seq.),
15 who shall treat the transferred funds as if the funds
16 were appropriated under section 2602(b) of that Act
17 (42 U.S.C. 8621) for fiscal year 2026.

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
