## A BILL

To improve transparency with respect to foreign influence on Department of Defense contractors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPROVING TRANSPARENCY OF FOREIGN IN-**  
4 **FLUENCE ON DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**  
5 **CONTRACTORS.**

6 (a) DEFENSE CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS  
7 GENERALLY.—Not later than 2 years after the date of  
8 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall  
9 revise the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supple-  
10 ment to require any company that is a prospective con-

1 tractor or subcontractor of the Department of Defense to  
2 provide to the Federal Government as part of any bid or  
3 proposal for a contract the information specified under  
4 subsection (a) of section 2876 of the National Defense Au-  
5 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018 (10 U.S.C. 2661  
6 note) for each beneficial owner (as that term is defined  
7 in subsection (d)(1) of such section) of such company.

8 (b) MITIGATION OF RISKS RELATED TO FOREIGN  
9 OWNERSHIP, CONTROL, OR INFLUENCE OF DEFENSE IN-  
10 DUSTRIAL BASE CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRAC-  
11 TORS.—Section 847(a) of the National Defense Authoriza-  
12 tion Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public Law 116–92; 10  
13 U.S.C. 4819 note) is amended—

14 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, and shall  
15 include any person defined as a ‘beneficial owner’  
16 under section 2876(d)(1) of the National Defense  
17 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018 (10 U.S.C.  
18 2661 note)” before the period at the end; and

19 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking “in excess of  
20 \$5,000,000” and inserting “in excess of \$500,000”.
