Mr. CURTIS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

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## A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to submit a strategy to Congress for countering Iranian and Hezbollah influence operations in Latin America.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLES.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Barring Adversarial  
5 Networks and Notorious Extremist Destabilizers in Latin  
6 America Act” or the “BANNED in Latin America Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. STRATEGY TO COUNTER IRANIAN AND HEZBOLLAH**  
8 **INFLUENCE OPERATIONS IN LATIN AMERICA.**

9 (a) STRATEGY REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days  
10 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary

1 of State shall submit a comprehensive strategy to the  
2 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate and the  
3 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representa-  
4 tives for countering Iran’s and Hezbollah’s propaganda,  
5 missionary networks, and influence operations in Latin  
6 America.

7 (b) CONTENTS OF STRATEGY.—The strategy re-  
8 quired under subsection (a) shall include—

9 (1) measures that address the proliferation of  
10 Iranian cultural centers in Latin America that pro-  
11 mote Iranian ideology, including diplomatic efforts  
12 to limit their operations, sanctions on affiliated enti-  
13 ties, and public diplomacy to expose their activities;

14 (2) actions that restrict the travel and activities  
15 of Iranian emissaries, including diplomats, cultural  
16 attaches, and other agents who facilitate propa-  
17 ganda, radicalization, and terror-supporting net-  
18 works in Latin America, through visa denials, sanc-  
19 tions, or other travel restrictions;

20 (3) initiatives that strengthen the capacity of  
21 United States intelligence agencies to identify, mon-  
22 itor, and disrupt Iran’s and Hezbollah’s networks,  
23 including their cooperation academic institutions and  
24 nongovernmental organizations in Latin America;

1           (4) a framework for taking actions, similar to  
2 those implemented against Al-Manar and Press TV,  
3 to disrupt Iran’s HispanTV and Hezbollah’s Al  
4 Mayadeen Español platforms, including sanctions,  
5 designations, and cooperation with regional partners  
6 to limit their broadcasting reach and digital pres-  
7 ence; and

8           (5) a plan to address Iran’s Al Mustafa Inter-  
9 national University network and its affiliated enti-  
10 ties, including by designating them as foreign ter-  
11 rorist organizations or specially designated global  
12 terrorists, as appropriate, due to their respective  
13 roles in radicalization and recruitment for Iran’s ide-  
14 ological and terrorist objectives.

15       (c) FORM.—The strategy required under subsection  
16 (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form and may in-  
17 clude a classified annex.

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
