2 **LONG TITLE**

3 **General Description:**

4 This bill provides a fee waiver for an individual applying for a driver license who is
5 experiencing homelessness.

6 **Highlighted Provisions:**

7 This bill:

- 9 ▶ provides a fee waiver for an individual who is experiencing homelessness who is
 - 10 applying for a driver license;
 - 11 ▶ provides the verification needed for the application to qualify for the fee waiver; and
 - 12 ▶ makes other technical changes for consistency.

20 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

21 Section 1. Section **53-3-105** is amended to read:

22 **53-3-105 . Fees for licenses, renewals, extensions, reinstatements, rescheduling,**
23 **and identification cards.**

24 Except as provided in Subsection (39), the following fees apply under this chapter:

- 25 (1) An original class D license application under Section 53-3-205 is \$52.
- 26 (2) An original provisional license application for a class D license under Section 53-3-205
27 is \$39.
- 28 (3) An original limited term license application under Section 53-3-205 is \$32.
- 29 (4) An original application for a motorcycle endorsement under Section 53-3-205 is \$18.

- 31 (5) An original application for a taxicab endorsement under Section 53-3-205 is \$14.
32 (6) A learner permit application under Section 53-3-210.5 is \$19.

47 (16) An extension of a taxicab endorsement under Section 53-3-214 is \$14.
48 (17) An extension of a class D license for an individual 65 and older under Section 53-3-214

50 (18) An original or renewal application for a commercial class A, B, or C license or an
51 original or renewal of a provisional commercial class A or B license under Part 4,
52 Uniform Commercial Driver License Act, is \$52.
53 (19) A commercial class A, B, or C license skills test is \$78.
54 (20) Each original CDL endorsement for passengers, hazardous material, double or triple
55 trailers, or tankers is \$9.
56 (21) An original CDL endorsement for a school bus under Part 4, Uniform Commercial
57 Driver License Act, is \$9.
58 (22) A renewal of a CDL endorsement under Part 4, Uniform Commercial Driver License
59 Act, is \$9.
60 (23)(a) A retake of a CDL knowledge test provided for in Section 53-3-205 is \$26.
61 (b) A retake of a CDL skills test provided for in Section 53-3-205 is \$52.
62 (24) A retake of a CDL endorsement test provided for in Section 53-3-205 is \$9.
63 (25) A duplicate class A, B, C, or D license certificate under Section 53-3-215 is \$23.
64 (26)(a) A license reinstatement application under Section 53-3-205 is \$40.

- 65 (b) A license reinstatement application under Section 53-3-205 for an alcohol, drug, or
66 combination of alcohol and any drug-related offense is \$45 in addition to the fee
67 under Subsection (26)(a).
- 68 (27)(a) An administrative fee for license reinstatement after an alcohol, drug, or
69 combination of alcohol and any drug-related offense under Section 41-6a-520,
70 53-3-223, or 53-3-231 or an alcohol, drug, or combination of alcohol and any
71 drug-related offense under Part 4, Uniform Commercial Driver License Act, is \$255.
- 72 (b) This administrative fee is in addition to the fees under Subsection (26).
- 73 (28)(a) An administrative fee for providing the driving record of a driver under Section
74 53-3-104 or 53-3-420 is \$8.
- 75 (b) The division may not charge for a report furnished under Section 53-3-104 to a
76 municipal, county, state, or federal agency.
- 77 (29) A rescheduling fee under Section 53-3-205 or 53-3-407 is \$25.
- 78 (30)(a) Except as provided under Subsections (30)(b) and (c), an identification card
79 application under Section 53-3-808 is \$23.
- 80 (b) An identification card application under Section 53-3-808 for a person with a
81 disability, as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 12102, is \$17.
- 82 (c) A fee may not be charged for an identification card application if the individual
83 applying:
- 84 (i)(A) has not been issued a Utah driver license;
85 (B) is indigent; and
86 (C) is at least 18 years old;
- 87 (ii) submits written verification that the individual is homeless, as defined in Section
88 26B-3-207, a person who is homeless, as defined in Section 35A-5-302, or a child
89 or youth who is homeless, as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11434a(2), from:
90 (A) a homeless shelter, as defined in Section 35A-16-305;
91 (B) a permanent housing, permanent[;] supportive, or transitional facility, as
92 defined in Section 35A-5-302;
93 (C) the Department of Workforce Services; [or]
94 (D) a homeless service provider as verified by the Department of Workforce
95 Services as described in Section 26B-8-113; or
96 [~~D~~] (E) a local educational agency liaison for homeless children and youth
97 designated under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii); or
98 (iii) is under 26 years old and submits written verification that the individual:

99 (A) is in the custody of the Division of Child and Family Services; or
100 (B) was in the custody of the Division of Child and Family Services but is no
101 longer in the custody of the Division of Child and Family Services due to the
102 individual's age.

103 (31)(a) An extension of a regular identification card under Subsection 53-3-807(4) for a
104 person with a disability, as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 12102, is \$17.

105 (b) The fee described in Subsection (31)(a) is waived if the applicant submits written
106 verification that the individual is homeless, as defined in Section 26B-3-207, or a
107 person who is homeless, as defined in Section 35A-5-302, or a child or youth who is
108 homeless, as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11434a(2), from:

109 (i) a homeless shelter, as defined in Section 35A-16-305;

110 (ii) a permanent housing, permanent[-] supportive, or transitional facility, as defined
111 in Section 35A-5-302;

112 (iii) the Department of Workforce Services;

113 (iv) a homeless service provider as verified by the Department of Workforce Services
114 as described in Section 26B-8-113; or

115 (v) a local educational agency liaison for homeless children and youth designated
116 under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii).

117 (32)(a) An extension of a regular identification card under Subsection 53-3-807(5) is
118 \$23.

119 (b) The fee described in Subsection (32)(a) is waived if the applicant submits written
120 verification that the individual is homeless, as defined in Section 26B-3-207, or a
121 person who is homeless, as defined in Section 35A-5-302, from:

122 (i) a homeless shelter, as defined in Section 35A-16-305;

123 (ii) a permanent housing, permanent[-] supportive, or transitional facility, as defined
124 in Section 35A-5-302;

125 (iii) the Department of Workforce Services; [~~or~~]

126 (iv) a homeless service provider as verified by the Department of Workforce Services
127 as described in Section 26B-8-113[-] ; or

128 (v) a local education agency liaison for homeless children and youth designated
129 under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii).

130 (33) In addition to any license application fees collected under this chapter, the division
131 shall impose on individuals submitting fingerprints in accordance with Section
132 53-3-205.5 the fees that the Bureau of Criminal Identification is authorized to collect for

- 133 the services the Bureau of Criminal Identification provides under Section 53-3-205.5.
- 134 (34) An original mobility vehicle permit application under Section 41-6a-1118 is \$30.
- 135 (35) A renewal of a mobility vehicle permit under Section 41-6a-1118 is \$30.
- 136 (36) A duplicate mobility vehicle permit under Section 41-6a-1118 is \$12.
- 137 (37) An original driving privilege card application under Section 53-3-207 is \$32.
- 138 (38) A renewal of a driving privilege card application under Section 53-3-207 is \$23.
- 139 (39) A fee may not be charged for an original class D license application, original
- 140 provisional license application for a class D license, or a learner permit application if the
- 141 individual applying[-is]:
- 142 (a)(i) is under the 26 years old; and
- 143 ~~[(b)]~~ (ii) submits written verification that the individual:
- 144 ~~[(i)]~~ (A) is in the custody of the Division of Child and Family Services; or
- 145 ~~[(ii)]~~ (B) was in the custody of the Division of Child and Family Services but is no
- 146 longer in the custody of the Division of Child and Family Services due to the
- 147 individual's age[-] ; or
- 148 (b) submits written verification that the individual is homeless, as defined in Section
- 149 26B-3-207, or is a person who is homeless, as defined in Section 35A-5-302, or a
- 150 child or youth who is homeless, as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11434a(2), from:
- 151 (i) a homeless shelter, as defined in Section 35A-16-305;
- 152 (ii) a permanent housing, permanent supportive, or transitional facility, as defined in
- 153 Section 35A-5-302;
- 154 (iii) the Department of Workforce Services;
- 155 (iv) a homeless service provider as verified by the Department of Workforce Services
- 156 as described in Section 26B-8-113; or
- 157 (v) a local educational agency liaison for homeless children and youth designated
- 158 under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii).
- 159 (40) An administrative fee to add an interdicted person identifier to a license certificate
- 160 under Section 53-3-236 or identification card under Section 53-3-805 is \$7.

161 **Section 2. Effective Date.**

162 This bill takes effect on May 6, 2026.
